Rev. Fr. Joseph Tuscan, OFM Cap., was professed as a Capuchin Franciscan Friar in the Province of St. Augustine in Pittsburgh, PA in 1990 and ordained to the priesthood on June 7, 1997 by Cardinal Wuerl of the Archdiocese of Washington, DC. A native of Ohio and raised in Canton, he currently serves in the Custody of St. John the Baptist in Puerto Rico, a territory his Province has served since 1930. In January of 1998, he was first assigned to the remote Southern Highlands Province of Papua New Guinea in the South Pacific where he served as a missionary priest until September 2001. From 2001 to the present Fr. Joseph has served in a variety of capacities including, parochial vicar, preaching, development and retreat ministry, spiritual director, director of priestly formation, hospital chaplaincy, military chaplaincy and pastor. He was asked by his superiors to learn Spanish in order to help begin a new outreach ministry of his Order in Florida in 2018. To that end, he currently serves as parochial vicar at Immaculate Conception Church in Aguada, Puerto Rico.
